Your Hair Is Growing Again

This September, we are going to follow the story of Samson -- a man who was chosen by God before he was born, who had great strength and a great calling, but who made some terrible choices. Samson's life was full of pain, bad decisions, and brokenness. But here is the good news: God was not finished with him.

The Bible says that even after Samson lost everything -- his strength, his eyes, his freedom, his purpose -- his hair began to grow again. That's a picture of God's grace. God never gives up on you. He can heal your wounds, forgive your mistakes, and restore your purpose.

This month, we will learn:

- How to acknowledge our wounds
- How to grieve our losses
- How to forgive those who hurt us
- How to receive God's love
- How to break free from lies
- How to walk in holiness and purity
- How to trust God for restoration

No matter what you have been through, no matter how broken you feel, God is not finished with you. Your hair is beginning to grow again.

HOW TO USE THIS

One page a day. Read it slow. Let it land.**01****READ**

Three Scriptures a day. Read them slowly -- out loud if you can.

02**SIT WITH IT**

Every lesson speaks to real life. Let it speak to what's actually going on with you.

03**PRAY IT**

Each day has a short prayer. Make it yours.

04**DECLARE IT**

End with the Word Affirmation. Speak it over your life.

A NOTE BEFORE YOU START

This month deals honestly with pain, brokenness, and things that were never your fault. If something you read stirs up something heavy, don't carry it alone -- talk to a parent, pastor, counselor, or another trusted adult in your life. God heals, and He often does it through people who love you.

STAGE 1

THE WOUND

DAYS 1-7

Before healing can begin, the wound has to be named. This stretch is honest about pain -- rejection, betrayal, brokenness -- the things Samson felt, and the things you may feel too.

DAY

01

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2026

God Sees the Cry of This Generation**TODAY'S WORD****Proverbs 1:7 (NKJV)***The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction.***Psalms 1:1-3 (ERV)***Great blessings belong to those who don't listen to evil advice, who don't live like sinners, and who don't join those who make fun of God. Instead, they love the Lord's teachings and think about them day and night. They are like trees planted near a stream. Their roots are strong, and their leaves are always green. They produce fruit in season, and everything they do succeeds.***Psalms 34:18 (NKJV)***The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit.***MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN*****Psalms 34:18 (NKJV) -- "The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart."*****THE REAL TALK**

Did you know that a lot of kids your age feel sad or lonely? Many kids carry big feelings inside that they don't know what to do with. Some feel like no one sees them. Some feel like they don't matter. But God sees everything, and He cares. The Bible says God is close to people who have broken hearts. That means He doesn't run away from your sadness. He comes near. He sits with you. He holds your heart gently. You don't have to pretend to be happy. You can bring all your feelings to God. He is big enough to handle them. And He promises to stay close.

PRAYER*God, thank You for being close to me when I'm sad. Help me know that You see me and You care. Amen.***SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE****"God is near to me when my heart is broken. He sees me and He cares."**

DAY

02

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 2, 2026

The Domino Effect of Brokenness**TODAY'S WORD****Proverbs 2:6-7 (NKJV)**

For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding; He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; He is a shield to those who walk uprightly.

Psalm 2:11-12 (ERV)

Serve the Lord with fear and trembling. Be glad and celebrate, but bow down to him with fear. Show that you obey his son, or he will be angry and destroy you. But everyone who goes to the son for safety is blessed.

Hebrews 12:15 (NKJV)

Looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled.

MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN

Hebrews 12:15 (NKJV) -- "Lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled."

THE REAL TALK

Have you ever seen a domino fall? One domino knocks over the next, and then the next, and soon they all fall down. That's what happens with hurt feelings. When someone hurts you and you don't deal with it, it can grow into anger, bitterness, and even hatred. That's the "domino effect of brokenness." The Bible warns us about a "root of bitterness." A root is something that grows deep and hard to pull out. Bitterness starts small, like being mad at someone, but if you let it stay, it grows bigger and hurts you more than it hurts anyone else. God wants to help you pull up those bitter roots before they grow too big.

PRAYER

God, please show me if I have any bitterness in my heart. Help me let it go before it grows. Amen.

SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE

"I will not let bitterness grow in my heart. I give my hurts to God."

DAY

03

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 3, 2026

The Pain That Drives Us

TODAY'S WORD

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NKJV)

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths.

Psalm 3:3-4 (NKJV)

But You, O Lord, are a shield for me, my glory and the One who lifts up my head. I cried to the Lord with my voice, and He heard me from His holy hill. Selah

Judges 14:1-3 (NKJV)

Now Samson went down to Timnah, and saw a woman in Timnah of the daughters of the Philistines. So he went up and told his father and mother, saying, 'I have seen a woman in Timnah of the daughters of the Philistines; now therefore, get her for me as a wife.' Then his father and mother said to him, 'Is there no woman among the daughters of your brethren, or among all my people, that you must go to get a wife from the uncircumcised Philistines?' And Samson said to his father, 'Get her for me, for she pleases me well.'

MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NKJV) -- "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding."

THE REAL TALK

When Samson saw a woman he liked, he didn't ask God. He didn't listen to his parents. He just did what felt good. Samson was looking for love and acceptance in the wrong places. Why? Because he had pain in his heart that he never dealt with. Sometimes when we are hurting, we try to make the pain go away by doing things that feel good, like eating too much sugar, watching too much TV, or looking for attention from people who don't really care about us. But those things never fix the pain. They just cover it up for a little while. God wants to heal the pain, not just cover it up. What pain are you trying to cover up?

PRAYER

God, please show me what pain I've been trying to cover up. Help me bring it to You instead of running from it. Amen.

SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE

"I don't have to cover my pain. I can bring it to God for real healing."

DAY

04

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2026

The Fractured Self**TODAY'S WORD****Proverbs 4:23 (NKJV)***Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life.***Psalms 4:7-8 (NKJV)***You have put gladness in my heart, more than in the season that their grain and wine increased. I will both lie down in peace, and sleep; for You alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety.***James 1:8 (NKJV)***He is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.***MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN*****James 1:8 (NKJV) -- "He is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways."*****THE REAL TALK**

Have you ever felt like two different people? One part of you wants to do the right thing, but another part wants to do something wrong? The Bible calls that being "double-minded." That means your heart and mind are split. You want to follow God, but you also want to do your own thing. Samson was like that. He was a Nazirite, set apart for God, but he lived like a Philistine. He had God's power but made bad choices. When we are double-minded, we are unstable, like a ship with two captains, both going different directions. God wants to heal your divided heart. He wants to make you whole, one person who loves Him completely.

PRAYER*God, please heal my divided heart. Help me love You with all my heart, not just part of it. Amen.***SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE****"God is healing my divided heart. I am becoming whole in Him."**

DAY

05

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 5, 2026

The Pain of Rejection**TODAY'S WORD****Proverbs 5:21 (NKJV)***For the ways of man are before the eyes of the Lord, and He ponders all his paths.***Psalms 5:11-12 (NKJV)***But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them; let those also who love Your name be joyful in You. For You, O Lord, will bless the righteous; with favor You will surround him as with a shield.***Judges 13:2-5 (NKJV)***Now there was a certain man from Zorah, of the family of the Danites, whose name was Manoah; his wife was barren and had no children. And the Angel of the Lord appeared to the woman and said to her, 'Indeed now, you are barren and have borne no children, but you shall conceive and bear a son. Now therefore, please be careful not to drink wine or similar drink, and not to eat anything unclean. For behold, you shall conceive and bear a son. And no razor shall come upon his head, for the child shall be a Nazirite to God from the womb; and he shall begin to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines.'***MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN*****Psalms 5:11-12 (NKJV) -- "Let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; with favor You will surround him as with a shield."*****THE REAL TALK**

Samson's mother was barren, she couldn't have children. In those days, that was a huge shame. People probably whispered about her. Samson grew up knowing that his parents struggled. And he grew up as an only child in a chaotic time. He probably felt alone and rejected. Rejection hurts. It hurts when your parents are too busy. It hurts when friends leave you out. It hurts when you feel like you don't belong. But God sees your rejection. He knows how it feels to be rejected, Jesus was rejected by His own people. And God wants to heal the pain of rejection. You belong to Him. You are accepted. You are loved.

PRAYER*God, rejection hurts. Please heal the places where I've felt rejected. Help me know that I belong to You. Amen.*

SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE

"I am accepted by God. I belong to Him forever."

DAY

06

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 6, 2026

The Pain of Betrayal**TODAY'S WORD****Proverbs 6:20-22 (NKJV)**

My son, keep your father's command, and do not forsake the law of your mother. Bind them continually upon your heart; tie them around your neck. When you roam, they will lead you; when you sleep, they will keep you; and when you awake, they will speak with you.

Psalms 6:8-9 (NKJV)

Depart from me, all you workers of iniquity; for the Lord has heard the voice of my weeping. The Lord has heard my supplication; the Lord will receive my prayer.

Judges 14:20 (NKJV)

But Samson's wife was given to his companion, who had been his best man.

MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN

Psalms 6:8-9 (NKJV) -- "The Lord has heard the voice of my weeping; the Lord will receive my prayer."

THE REAL TALK

Samson married a Philistine woman, but during the wedding, things went wrong. Before the celebration was even over, his wife was given to another man. Imagine that, the person you trusted most was taken away. Betrayal hurts deeply. Maybe someone promised to be your friend but then turned against you. Maybe someone you trusted lied to you or left you. Betrayal can make you feel like you can't trust anyone. But God sees your betrayal. He knows what it feels like to be betrayed, Jesus was betrayed by Judas, one of His own disciples. And God wants to heal the pain of betrayal. You can trust Him, even when you can't trust people.

PRAYER

God, betrayal hurts. Please heal my heart where I've been betrayed. Help me trust You, even when I can't trust others. Amen.

SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE

"God sees my betrayal and He will heal me. I can trust Him."

DAY

07

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 7, 2026

Samson's Pain Points**TODAY'S WORD****Proverbs 7:1-3 (NKJV)**

My son, keep my words, and treasure my commands within you. Keep my commands and live, and my law as the apple of your eye. Bind them on your fingers; write them on the tablet of your heart.

Psalms 7:17 (NKJV)

I will praise the Lord according to His righteousness, and will sing praise to the name of the Lord Most High.

Judges 16:18-20 (NKJV)

When Delilah saw that he had told her all his heart, she sent and called for the lords of the Philistines, saying, 'Come up once more, for he has told me all his heart.' So the lords of the Philistines came up to her and brought the money in their hand. Then she lulled him to sleep on her knees, and called for a man and had him shave off the seven locks of his head. Then she began to torment him, and his strength left him. And she said, 'The Philistines are upon you, Samson!' So he awoke from his sleep, and said, 'I will go out as before, at other times, and shake myself free!' But he did not know that the Lord had departed from him.

MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN

Psalms 7:17 (NKJV) -- "I will praise the Lord according to His righteousness."

THE REAL TALK

Samson had a lot of pain in his life. He was rejected by his parents in some ways. He was betrayed by his wife. He was betrayed by Delilah. His own people turned him over to the Philistines. And he was very alone. All that pain made him make bad choices. He chased women who didn't love him. He got angry and took revenge. He broke the promises he made to God. When we have unhealed pain, we often make bad choices too. We get angry. We act out. We chase things that hurt us. But God wants to heal our pain so we can make better choices. You don't have to carry your pain alone. God wants to heal it.

PRAYER

God, please heal the pain I've been carrying. Help me not make bad choices because of my hurt. Amen.

SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE

"God is healing my pain so I can make better choices."

STAGE 2

THE TURNING POINT

DAYS 8-10

Hope isn't denial -- it's the first step back. This short stretch is about the moment pain turns toward repentance and a real turning point with God.

DAY

08

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2026

The Hope That Begins Healing**TODAY'S WORD****Proverbs 8:17 (NKJV)***I love those who love me, and those who seek me diligently will find me.***Psalms 8:3-4 (NKJV)***When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have ordained, what is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of man that You visit him?***Judges 16:22 (NKJV)***However, the hair of his head began to grow again after it had been shaved.***MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN*****Judges 16:22 (NKJV) -- "The hair of his head began to grow again after it had been shaved."*****THE REAL TALK**

Samson was in prison. He was blind, bound, and grinding grain like a donkey. He had lost everything, his strength, his eyes, his purpose. It seemed like God was done with him. But the Bible says one of the most hopeful verses in all of Scripture: "However, the hair of his head began to grow again." That little word "however" changes everything. Samson's hair growing back meant God wasn't finished with him. Grace was working even before Samson prayed. That's the hope you have too. No matter how badly you've messed up, God isn't finished with you. He is already working to restore you. Your "hair" is beginning to grow again.

PRAYER*God, thank You that You are not finished with me. Please help me see the signs of Your grace in my life. Amen.***SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE****"God is not finished with me. Grace is already at work in my life."**

DAY

09

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2026

Repentance, The Turning Point**TODAY'S WORD****Proverbs 9:10 (NKJV)***The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.***Psalms 9:9-10 (NKJV)***The Lord also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; for You, Lord, have not forsaken those who seek You.***Judges 16:28 (NKJV)***Then Samson called to the Lord, saying, 'O Lord GOD, please remember me and strengthen me, just once more, O God, so that I may with one blow take vengeance on the Philistines for my two eyes.'***MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN*****Judges 16:28 (NKJV) -- "O Lord GOD, please remember me and strengthen me, just once more."*****THE REAL TALK**

Samson had hit rock bottom. He was blind and in prison. He had lost everything. And then he prayed. He didn't pray a fancy prayer. He just cried out to God: "Please remember me and strengthen me just once more." That's repentance. It's turning to God when you've messed up. It's admitting you can't do it on your own. Samson didn't make excuses. He didn't blame others. He just cried out to God. And God answered. Repentance isn't about feeling bad enough, it's about turning to God. If you've messed up, you don't have to fix yourself first. Just turn to God and ask for help. He will answer.

PRAYER*God, I've messed up. Please remember me and strengthen me. I turn to You. Amen.***SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE****"When I repent, God hears me and strengthens me."**

DAY

10

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 2026

The Marks of Genuine Repentance

TODAY'S WORD

Proverbs 10:19 (NKJV)

In the multitude of words sin is not lacking, but he who restrains his lips is wise.

Psalms 10:17-18 (NKJV)

Lord, You have heard the desire of the humble; You will prepare their heart; You will cause Your ear to hear, to do justice to the fatherless and the oppressed, that the man of the earth may oppress no more.

Luke 3:8-9 (NKJV)

Therefore bear fruits worthy of repentance, and do not begin to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' For I say to you that God is able to raise up children to Abraham from these stones. And even now the ax is laid to the root of the trees. Therefore every tree which does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.

MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN

Luke 3:8 (NKJV) -- "Bear fruits worthy of repentance."

THE REAL TALK

Repentance isn't just saying "I'm sorry." It's showing that you've changed. John the Baptist told people to "bear fruits worthy of repentance", that means your actions should show that you've really changed. Samson's repentance was real because his heart changed. He stopped living for himself and asked God to use him again. Real repentance isn't just feeling bad, it's turning around and going the other way. If you've said sorry but keep doing the same thing, that's not real repentance. Real repentance means you change. And when you change, God is ready to use you again.

PRAYER

God, help me not just say I'm sorry, help me really change. Show me the fruit You want to see in my life. Amen.

SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE

"Real repentance means real change. I will show God's love by how I live."

STAGE 3

THE HEALING PROCESS

DAYS 11-16

Healing has steps: acknowledge the wound, grieve the loss, forgive the offender, receive God's love, break the ungodly agreements. This is the road to wholeness.

DAY

11

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2026

Acknowledge the Wound**TODAY'S WORD****Proverbs 11:24-25 (NKJV)**

There is one who scatters, yet increases more; and there is one who withholds more than is right, but it leads to poverty. The generous soul will be made rich, and he who waters will also be watered himself.

Psalms 11:4-5 (NKJV)

The Lord is in His holy temple, the Lord's throne is in heaven; His eyes behold, His eyelids test the sons of men. The Lord tests the righteous, but the wicked and the one who loves violence His soul hates.

Psalms 34:18 (NKJV)

The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit.

MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN

Psalms 34:18 (NKJV) -- "The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart."

THE REAL TALK

The first step to healing is admitting you're hurt. You can't heal a wound you pretend doesn't exist. If you have a cut on your arm, you don't just put a bandage on it without cleaning it first. You have to look at it, clean it, and care for it. It's the same with your heart. If you've been hurt, by words, by actions, by people, you need to admit it. You can tell God: "This hurt me. This still hurts. I need Your help." God doesn't shame you for being wounded. He comes close to the brokenhearted. He wants to heal you. But you have to let Him see the wound.

PRAYER

God, I admit I've been hurt. Please heal the wounds in my heart that I've been ignoring. Amen.

SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE

"I acknowledge my wounds so God can heal them."

DAY

12

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2026

Grieve the Loss**TODAY'S WORD****Proverbs 12:25 (NKJV)***Anxiety in the heart of man causes depression, but a good word makes it glad.***Psalms 12:5-6 (NKJV)***For the oppression of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, now I will arise," says the Lord; "I will set him in the safety for which he yearns." The words of the Lord are pure words, like silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times.***Lamentations 3:19-23 (NKJV)***Remember my affliction and roaming, the wormwood and the gall. My soul still remembers and sinks within me. This I recall to my mind, therefore I have hope. Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.***MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN*****Lamentations 3:22-23 (NKJV) -- "Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning."*****THE REAL TALK**

Have you ever lost something important to you? Maybe a pet died. Maybe a friend moved away. Maybe you lost a dream you had. Loss hurts. And it's okay to be sad about it. Sometimes people tell us to "get over it" or "stop crying." But God doesn't say that. The book of Lamentations is a whole book of crying out to God about loss. Samson probably never cried, he just got angry. But grief is important. It's letting the sadness out so it doesn't stay stuck inside. You don't have to pretend you're not sad. You can bring your sadness to God. He will comfort you.

PRAYER*God, I'm sad about some losses in my life. Please comfort me and help me grieve. Amen.***SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE****"I can bring my sadness to God. He will comfort me."**

DAY

13

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2026

Forgive the Offender**TODAY'S WORD****Proverbs 13:12 (NKJV)***Hope deferred makes the heart sick, but when the desire comes, it is a tree of life.***Psalms 13:5-6 (NKJV)***But I have trusted in Your mercy; my heart shall rejoice in Your salvation. I will sing to the Lord, because He has dealt bountifully with me.***Ephesians 4:31-32 (NKJV)***Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.***MEMORY VERSE - LOCK IT IN*****Ephesians 4:32 (NKJV) -- "Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you."*****THE REAL TALK**

Forgiveness is hard. When someone hurts you, it feels unfair to forgive them. But the Bible says we should forgive because God forgave us. God forgave us when we didn't deserve it. And He wants us to forgive others, not because they deserve it, but because it frees us. When you hold onto anger, it hurts you more than it hurts the other person. Forgiveness doesn't mean what they did was okay. It means you give the pain to God so it doesn't poison your heart. You can forgive someone and still tell a safe adult if you're being hurt. Forgiveness is for your freedom.

PRAYER*God, please help me forgive the people who have hurt me. I give my pain to You. Amen.***SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE****"I forgive others because God forgave me."**

DAY

14

When people hurt us, we sometimes start believing lies. We believe things like: "I'm worthless." "No one will ever love me." "I'm a bad person." "God is angry with me." These are called "ungodly agreements", we agree with a lie instead of God's truth. Samson believed the lie that his strength was in his hair, not in his consecration to God. And it destroyed him. But God's truth sets us free. Jesus said, "You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." What lies have you been believing? Write them down. Then write the truth that God says about you.

PRAYER*God, please show me the lies I've been believing. Help me exchange them for Your truth. Amen.***SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE****"I break every lie and receive God's truth."**

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 2026

Healing doesn't happen alone. God made us to need each other. When we confess our sins and struggles to safe people, we find healing. James says we should confess our sins to one another and pray for each other. That doesn't mean you tell everyone everything, it means you find safe people you can trust. Samson had no one. He was isolated, and he fell. You need people who will speak truth to you, pray for you, and help you stay on track. Who is your safe person?

PRAYER*God, please give me safe people who can help me stay on track and pray for me. Amen.***SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE****"Healing happens in community. I need safe people in my life."**

HOLINESS & RESTORED STRENGTH

DAYS 17-22

Holiness was never about being perfect -- it's about being set apart. This stretch connects your healing to a daily walk with God, and shows how He uses broken people to do great things.

I want to live for You." It's not about being flawless, it's about being faithful. You will make mistakes. But you can still be set apart. You can still say, "God, I'm Yours." That's holiness.

PRAYER*God, I want to be set apart for You. Help me live like I belong to You. Amen.***SPEAK IT OVER YOUR LIFE****"I am set apart for God. Holiness is my calling."**

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 2026

The Connection Between Healing and Holiness

TODAY'S WORD

Proverbs 18:10 (NKJV)

The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.

I will love You, O Lord, my strength. The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

God wants to heal you so you can be holy.

Just like Samson's hair grew back, your heart is being healed, little by little, day by day.

So, What Now?
